I am an ASP developer that is not really ready to move to ASP.NET. I find it a little intimidating, and frankly not too necessary in most coding situations. On the other hand, I dig XML Web Services. They act just like component extensions, but my companies server people were dead-set on NOT adding the .NET framework to the server.

The Web Service Listener has worked flawlessly. It is another COM component, with only a few routines--simple. I was able to communicate easliy to a wide variety of Web Services in minutes. The samples they gave were in ASP, so all I had to do was modify where the samples were going. The component is solid in my opinion, and beats me having to code, SOAP to talk to one service, and XML to talk to another, and so on. I give it the Ol' two thumbs up!
