They said they do not allow changing the license to another URL! And if you or your client happens to change domain names? Then you are sure out of luck, unless you are willing to purchase a new copy. I would steer clear of this company and not be enticed by the product, which can quickly become useless to you.

Also, I asked them what it would cost for me to upgrade.. They said I would have to pay \$39 and \$35 for a service fee for a total of \$74 (I kid you not). This is more than it cost to buy a new copy!

Comdev Newsletter 3.1 is easy to install and use, and provides good capabilities to maintain a subscriber email list. Its main weakness is emailing out, which can be batched to avoid server timeouts, and is brutally slow. I could not get the bounced email function to work properly, and tech support has basically given up trying to solve what I think is a bug in the program.
