The Amazon Webstore is very easy to install and setup, even for a novice user. It requires very little or no knowledge of PHP to get the site up and running.

I used the Amazon Webstore to replace some custom code that I had been using for several years -- it's just easier to maintain and hassle free. The system even tells you when there are upgrades available!

My only wish is that the code ran a little faster. It can be a bit sluggish running searches and displaying results. I haven't done enough digging, so it may be just the Amazon API operating slowly.
