I'm disappointed in the script. As far as I'm concerned I just waited my money.

1. The documentation is very, very poor. If something does not work properly there's no place to go for help. When purchasing the scripts, the author states on his website that you are taking this script as is – and there's no support unless you pay for that support. Fine – that's OK, but very disappointing when you start to read the setup file – only has a couple of lines.
2. the install script does not work – for me anyway – I've tried just about everything and it still will not install.
3. manage to create my tables in the database – but now error keep cropping up and again there is no where to go for help.
4. documentation needs to be much better
5. I don't recommend the script – find something that is free and much better and has at least a forum – this one does not.
