Its a shame this chat app. has so little activity (not upgraded significantly in 2 years) since it has a lot of potential.

I have a couple of issues with it - first, it continuously refreshes, meaning that every connected user uses a lot of bandwidth, even if nobody is chatting. Second, since it is flash, resizing only changes the size, so maximize it full screen and you have something like 40 point text, but still only 14 lines of text.

That said, this is the best chat app I have found that does not use a server-side component. all the HTML only ones flicker and click all the time when they refresh, so at least flash gets around this problem.
