First you have to be able to get pear going and installed, if you know how to do this, good for you, if not, once again, good luck.

Then you find out you have to have the latest version of mysql, which is easy to install but stuffs up any websites you're running that use databases made in earlier versions of mysql

Then you have to adjust your http.conf file with aliases that stop any other site running and redirect it to the (not working) matrix cms

Overall its just been a complete pain the rear end, I've tried many times now to get the thing running, but it just keeps stuffing up and taking my server with it

I give it two thumbs down until they pull their heads out and do something about the horrific installation process. Never even got a chance to see if all the grief was worth it cos I couldn't get the thing running, and they don't run a live demo on their site (perhaps they couldn't get it going either)
