Simply change your links to point to jump.cgi then add the real url you are linking to

after the ?url= part. ie:

Great idea, but it doesn't work properly. If you copy and paste the URL into your web browser address line, the referrer is blank. However, if you have a link on your web site (ie. `http://www.example.com/cgi-bin/jump.cgi?url=http://newsite.com`) the referring URL *is* still tracked.
