As advertised, this script is very quick and easy to install, and the clean administrative interface is fairly intuitive. It lacks some very basic features, and is extremely unforgiving of the slightest syntax error in any HTML coding entered. No error messages, or guidance... it merely discards the revision, and you get to start over. Similarly, text containing quotation marks, apostrophes, or any reserved characters are just rejected. There is no documentation, not even a "ReadMe."
