I have spent weeks looking for a Paypal IPN script that I could use to sell my MP3's... Some were wat too complicated for my level of web skills, some looked too unattractive (and uneditable) and some just plain didn't work.

The cost varied from £10 to £300 however after finding this Script "PHP IPN-Monitor" through hotscripts.com for a snip at \$49 (which equated to around £28 GBP) I was delighted. Absolutely perfect. Soooo simple to set up, great admin user interface and different ways of presenting your store to your eagerly awaiting public. You can either use a simlpe 'include' statement:

```

Anywhere on your page where you want it to appear... And that's it. You can also 'Create Buttons By Hand' so you can place a 'buy now' button wherever you like. A good set of documents on the developers website were simple and well presented. I would absolutley highly recommend this script for anyone looking to sell digital products via a download link (provided as a button)... Brilliant
